Ernie Newman to Teach in Samoa

Ernie has been invited to teach woodturning in Samoa by a master carver, Penehuro Papalii. Because of the recent tsunami and earthquake that had such a major impact in Samoa, he is very keen to assist. He is hoping for your support to make this trip a success. Penehuro runs the Beautiful Expressions of Nature Fine Arts Academy in Apia, the capital of Samoa. They believe his students can make a commercial success of turning small items for sale to tourists through his gallery and at the daily market in the city.

The main focus of the school is carving but, although it has two lathes, Penehuro has limited knowledge of turning so Ernie can make a difference. His aim would be to teach commercial techniques so that Pehehuro's students (young men from 14-20) could earn a living through woodturning. He also hopes to train Penehuro and one, or more, of his assistants to carry on teaching after he return to Australia.

Ernie plans to go to Samoa in February and will pay his fare. He asks you to consider contributing because he needs to acquire lathes, chucks and tools. If interested in contributing, contact Bob Clancy at 281-4469.
